Called to order at 12:15 PM

Sherrie: Michigan State Police have a program for 6th grade and up; they also have programs re drug awareness and making good decisions. Sherrie was referred to CTC Board member, Trooper Butler, who remains interested by over-booked at this time.

Boy Scouts in this area are grades 1-5. May start 6th grade troop next year.

High 5 Mentoring/Big Brother/Big Sisters have not called back after leaving 2 messages for each.

Chad: Churches: people are often out of office. Youth programs that did call back were religious education only. They address our priorities in a round-about way.

Great Start Collaborative: Early childhood programming, but not much in Baraga County. They will try to send someone. They may have funding for trainings.

Community Foundation: Gordette has been out of office a lot.

Pam Dove: Unable to attend. Sent email with information from contacts she made. She will provide additional follow-up. Dial Help has prevention programs.

Health Dept. can offer a prevention program in the schools.

Suggests we interview Kevin at Dial Help and Barb at Health Department.

Becky: Healing-to-Wellness Court addresses treatment with college age population.

Shelter Home: Programs are for primary and secondary victims of domestic and sexual assault. Teen violence survivors group and individual treatment are also available. Have a curriculum re: violence for schools but lack of funding has prevented implementation.

Could not reach HopeWorks Counseling – individual treatment.

CCCMH/The Institute: Have offered Strengthening Families Program in past. May no longer have funding. The Institute is the prevention/substance abuse center for CMH.

UPSET: They are out doing training, have not been able to reach them.

Laura: RSVP – not available.

Something Better: working on building; want to get it insured. Will be offering vacation bible school. They are looking for funding.

SHYP Program: New staffer has only been on board for a week; she will call back. Ages 16-21. 4 apartments for homeless/at risk of homelessness youth. As part of that program, they offer services for independent living.

Did not hear from Kim Henderson.
